Mark Tasker is the Head of Marine Advice at the UK's Joint Nature Conservation Committee (JNCC – [www.jncc.gov.uk](http://www.jncc.gov.uk)), based in Aberdeen.

His responsibility is to advise on the nature conservation of the UK's seas and oceans, including those of UK's overseas territories, and of those organisms that use these areas. He is also a Vice-Chair of the Advisory Committee of the International Council for the Exploration of the Seas (ICES – [www.ices.dk](http://www.ices.dk)), a part-time paid post and is responsible for the marine ecosystem advice given by ICES, mostly to international governance bodies.

He has worked and published on a wide range of marine issues including seabirds, marine mammals, cold-water corals, underwater noise, impacts of human activities on marine ecosystems and nature conservation strategies.
